Best of Breed Competition

Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries For Each Specialty

Veteran Dog Class • Veteran Bitch Class

For Old English Sheepdogs who are at least 7 years of age or older on the day of the show.

Dogs & Bitches entered in Veteran Class may be spayed or neutered.

The first place Winner, if undefeated in the show, is eligible to compete for Best of Breed Competition.

Shaved Coat Class for Old English Sheepdog AKC Titled Dogs

Rules:

1. Dog must have an AKC title

2. Class Divided by Sex

3. Dog may have no longer than 2" of regrowth to the coat on any part of the body, head or legs or will be ineligible for this class. At the judge's discretion or by protest, the judge will measure coat length.

4. Spayed and Neutered dogs are not eligible for this class.

5. The first place dog and the first place bitch that are undefeated are eligible to compete in Best of Breed Competition.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

National Only

Stud Dog Class – For Stud Dogs and at least two, and not more than four of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition, but must be entered in the Stud Dog class. The Stud Dog may be entered in the Stud Dog Class only at the regular entry fee. The Get must be entered in one of the Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition. The Stud Dog shall be considered one entry and requires one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the dog show rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed.

Brood Bitch Class - same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

*Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed Bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

Brace Class - A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time the entry is made. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for "Additional Class" if more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be so designated "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2." Please submit brace entries together.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, and Brace classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won either of these classes.

****Points Available for Reserve****

The Old English Sheepdog Club of America, Inc. will award at its *National Specialty* a three point major to Reserve Winners Dog if the Regular Class Dog entry is twice the required number for a five point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.

The Old English Sheepdog Club of America, Inc. will award at its *National Specialty* a three point major to Reserve Winners Bitch if the Regular Class Bitch entry is twice the required number for a five point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.

Sweepstakes (Each Specialty)

Requirement for Sweepstakes

Open to Old English Sheepdogs at least six (6) months of age and under eighteen (18) months of age on the day of the show. - Open-Standard, JWW and FAST (preferred or regular): Total score plus 10 points.
- Novice-Standard, JWW and FAST (preferred or regular): Total score plus 5 points.
- T2B (preferred or regular): Total points awarded multiplied by 10.
- A dog that qualifies in 2 out of the 4 classes will be awarded an additional 5 points.
- A dog that qualifies in 3 out of 4 classes will be awarded an additional 8 points.
- A dog that qualifies 4 out of 4 classes will be awarded an additional 10 points.
- High in Trial winner will be awarded an additional 5 points.

OBEDIENCE:

Only the highest qualifying score of a dog's obedience scores will be counted in this event.

Regular, optional titling and non-regular classes will all count towards this competition.

- Utility: 50% of total score plus 15 points.
- Open: 50% of total score plus 10 points.
- Novice or Veterans: 50% of total score plus 5 points.
- Beginner Novice or Preferred Novice: 50% of total score.
