Test/Trial Entries Close August 24, 2022 at 5 P.M. EST Day of Show entries for Farm Dog until 11:00 AM

- A separate form must be submitted for each dog entered.
- Entries not on Official AKC entry forms or photocopies without the agreement and rules are unacceptable.
- Entries will not be accepted without fees.
- No refund for duplicate entries or for any other cause beyond the control of the Old English Sheepdog Club of America (OESCA) will be made after the closing date.
- Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms (whomever may make such errors) and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the closing date. Changes, additions, or corrections to the entry form must be received in writing prior to the closing date.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The treasurer will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. All fees must be submitted in US funds.
- Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, not allowed to compete in the entered class, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of OESCA it is impossible to open or complete the Test/Trial classes, no refund will be made.
- The OESCA may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause and no one shall have claim or recourse against the OESCA or any official thereof.
- After the closing date, no entries can be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted.

ALTERNATES LIST

- Entries received after the numerical limits have been reached but prior to closing will be placed on an alternates list. If you DO NOT wish to be on the alternates list, please enclose a signed statement to that effect with your entry. The alternates list will be used to fill vacancies in the drawn running order, with the first available alternate entry replacing the first vacancy in the class entered.
- Per Chapter 1, Section 13 of the Herding Regulations, "In tests and for move-ups from a test class to a trial class, alternate entries shall be given priority over dogs that are eligible to be moved-up. Within the trial classes, requests to move-up shall be given priority over alternate entries.
- Alternates will be permitted to run if there is an absentee in an earlier class (provided the alternate's class has not begun) which was not filled on the same course, same type of livestock and under the same Judge, or if a dog has been marked absent with the Event Secretary prior to the beginning of the alternate's class.
- Entry fees will be refunded for alternates whose dogs do not run.

HANDLERS MEETING: There will be a handlers meeting at the beginning of each class.

LUNCH BREAK will be scheduled at the judge's discretion.

WHEN NOT COMPETING, dogs must be confined or held on leash and kept away from the livestock. NO LOOSE DOGS!

BITCHES IN SEASON are permitted to run. They will be placed at the end of the running order in test classes and run in catalog order in trial classes.

EXHIBITORS should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Email will be used as a primary means of communication if an email address is listed on the entry form unless entrant requests otherwise.

PLEASE CLEAN UP after your dog at the site and hotel.

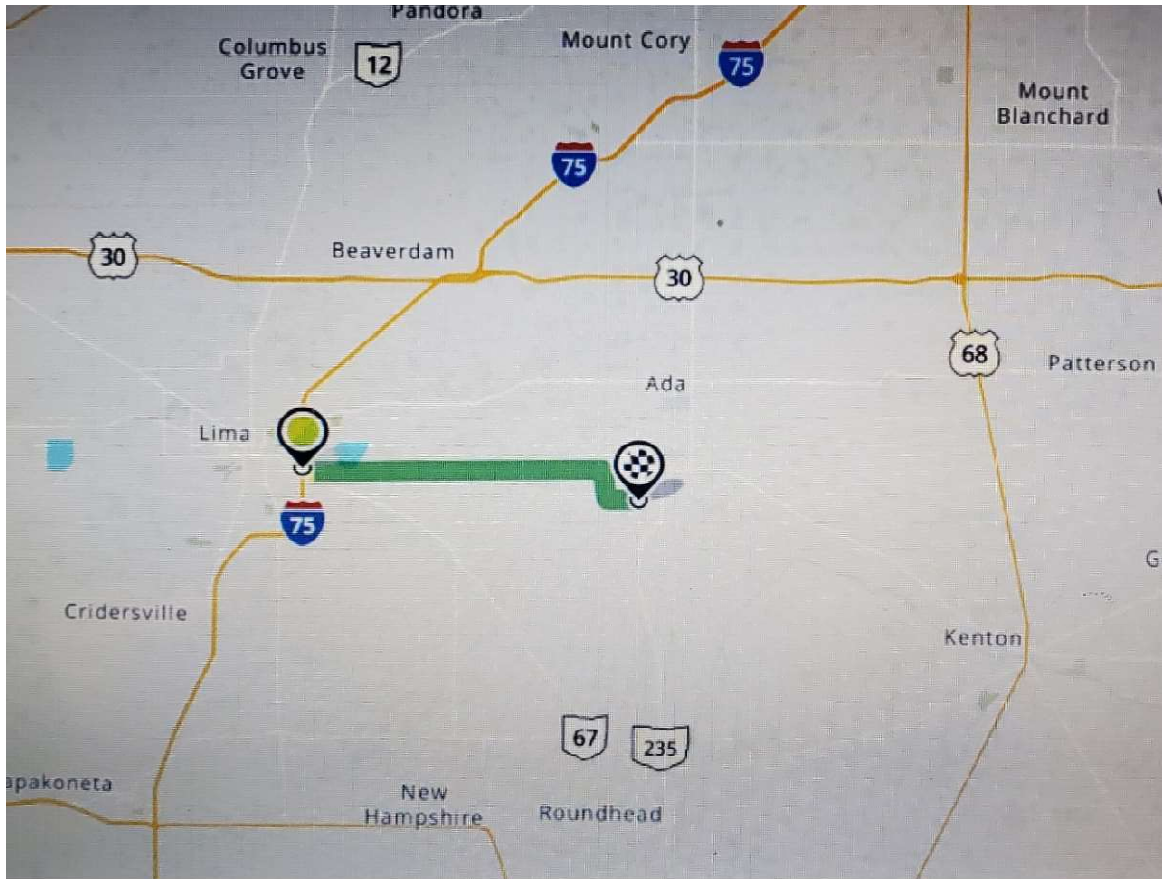


Directions to trial site

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline" and the "Regulations for Herding Tests & Trials" have been made available to me (us), and that I (we) agree that the club holding this Herding Test or Trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Herding Test or Trial and of the opportunity to have the dog tested or judged and to win ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the Herding Test or Trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be abused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other causes. I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this Herding Test or Trial, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.
